Keeney Arrested After Pursuit

A Science Hill man was arrested early Tuesday morning after he led local law enforcement officers on a 20-minute chase.

Scott Keeney, age 35, was pulled over by Somerset Police Officer Chris Roberts for a traffic violation near the intersection of US 27 and KY 80 at 1:56 AM Tuesday.

Officer Roberts requested Keeney to exit the car, but Keeney sped away. Keeney led officers through several side streets and the Lake Cumberland Regional Hospital before going west on KY 80 into Nancy. Officers observed a bag being thrown from the car near Fishing Creek that was later identified as pseudoephedrine.

From Nancy, the pursuit went east on the Cumberland Parkway towards Somerset. It ended near the Fishing Creek Bridge when sheriff deputies deployed Stop Sticks and Keeney's vehicle was disabled.

Keeney was arrested and charged with Fleeing or Evading Police 1st Degree, Tampering with Physical Evidence, DUI 1st, Failure of a Non-Operator to Maintain Insurance, and Unlawful Possession of a Meth Precursor.

Keeney was lodged in the Pulaski County Detention Center.

SPD units were assisted by the Pulaski County Sheriff Department.
