Two Fugitives Arrested in Somerset

Two fugitives were arrested over the weekend from two different states.

On Saturday morning at 12:33 AM, Officer Kevin Bickford responded to a domestic situation on College Street.

When patrol units arrived, Bryan Nurge, 25, fled out the back door. He was later found during a search of the area and was arrested for Alcohol Intoxication. An NCIC computer check revealed he was wanted by the Dearborn County Sheriff Department in Indiana for Probation Violation.

Nurge was lodged in the Pulaski County Detention Center.

On Sunday afternoon, Officer William Cowan conducted a traffic stop on US 27. A rear passenger, Glenn Spence, Jr. did not have any identification in his possession.

An NCIC computer check showed Spencer was wanted by the Harrison County Sheriff's Department in Texas for burglary charges.

He was also lodged in the Pulaski County Detention Center.

Each suspect will be arraigned before a Pulaski District Court Judge to determine extradition back to the respective states for prosecution.
