Wesley Arrested After Knife Attack

Somerset police units responded to a fight in progress call on Saturday, January 3, 2008 at 9:15PM. When units arrived at the North College Street residence, they discovered Tony Owens, 28, suffering from lacerations to the neck and left arm. Owens had been arguing with William Lee Wesley, 28, of Mt. Vernon, who witnesses say pulled out a knife and began attacking Owens.

The search then began Wesley, who fled the scene before officers arrived.

Somerset officer Eric Moore and K9 Aras responded to the scene and began tracking Wesley. He was found a short distance away hiding in bushes. Officers then discovered Wesley cut himself in the stomach during the attack.

Both were treated at the scene by the Somerset Fire/EMS and were treated at the Lake Cumberland Regional Hospital for their injuries.

Wesley was released from the emergency room and lodged in the Pulaski County Detention Center. He was charged with Alcohol Intoxication and Assault 2nd Degree, a felony.
