Fugitive Arrested

Somerset police officers have arrested a Lancaster, Ky. man wanted in three counties.

On Tuesday, SPD units were notified that Shamar Lewis was staying in a local motel and was wanted in Boyle, Lincoln, and Garrard Counties.

Patrol units responded to the scene and took Lewis, age 25, of Lancaster, into custody without incident at 11:14 AM.

Lewis was wanted on a Lincoln County warrant charging him with Attempted Murder of a Police Officer, Wanton Endangerment 1st Degree, Fleeing or Evading Police 1st Degree, and other traffic offenses from a 2008 case investigated by the Kentucky State Police.

His was wanted on a Boyle County Domestic Violence Warrant for failing to attend counseling.

Garrard County had an Indictment from a domestic dispute in October 2008 that produced charges for assault, criminal mischief, persistent felony offender, and violation of an EPD/DVO.

The last warrant handed down by the Kentucky Parole Board for violating the terms of his parole on Pulaski County burglary charges in 2003.

Lewis was handed over to a trooper from the Richmond Post, and remains lodged in the Lincoln County Detention Center.
