Cowan Arrested After Domestic Situation

At 8:30 AM Monday, Somerset police units responded to a domestic situation at Budget Inn.

When Officer Greg Martin arrived on the scene, he observed a gray Dodge Intrepid pulling into a parking space, next to a Black Chevrolet Cavalier.

Further investigation revealed the driver of the Intrepid, Sonja Cowan, 39, of Bowling Green, Ky., had been looking for her ex-boyfriend, Alejandro Enriquez, and found him at the motel. Cowan confronted Enriquez and another occupant in the room, Trilissa Conatser, and an argument ensued.

After the argument, Cowan got in her vehicle and appeared to leave, but rammed the Cavalier with her Dodge Intrepid.

The impact caused the Cavalier to go over the curb and sidewalk, and then into the motel room where Enriquez and Conatser had been staying. Conatser was standing between the Cavalier and a concrete retaining wall, but was uninjured. No other injuries were reported.

Officer Martin arrested Cowan on the scene without incident and charged her with: Operating on a Suspended License, No Insurance, Criminal Mischief 1st Degree (felony), and Wanton Endangerment 1st Degree (felony).

Cowan was lodged in the Pulaski County Detention Center.
