Three Arrested After Somerset Home Invasion

Shortly before 5:00 AM Thursday, Somerset police units were notified of a home invasion robbery in the Sunset Trailer Park on Ringgold Road.

As officers were responding to the scene, Sgt. Brad Stevens observed the suspect's vehicle on Losey Street and conducted a traffic stop on West Columbia Street.

The three occupants of the vehicle were identified as Erica Gilmore, 21, of Tateville; Kyle Wright, Jr., 19, of Somerset; and David Vance, 24, of Somerset.

The investigation revealed Gilmore knocked on the door of an elderly female's trailer and pretended to be involved in a domestic situation with her boyfriend.

When the female opened the door, Gilmore and Vance entered, and Vance held the female at gunpoint until the couple left with her property.

A firearm and the victim's property were recovered as a result of the traffic stop.

All three were charged with Robbery 1st Degree, Receiving Stolen Property Under \$300, and Tampering with Physical Evidence. Vance and Wright were additionally charged with Receiving a Stolen Firearm. All three were lodged in the Pulaski County Detention Center.

The case is being investigated by Detective Chris Gates.
