Somerset Man Killed in Injury Accident

On May 20, 2008 at 2:46 PM, Somerset police responded to an injury accident at the intersection of US 27 and Langdon Street.

When units arrived they found a 2003 Lincoln driven by Blaine Correll, 86, of Cardinal Hills, Somerset was southbound on US 27, approaching the intersection of Langdon Street.

Correll's Lincoln struck 1995 Oldsmobile, driven by Baker Carter, 84, of Canary Avenue in Somerset that was eastbound on Langdon Street.

The impact caused both vehicles to come to rest in the intersection.

Correll and Carter were treated at the scene by the Somerset Fire/EMS. Correll was transported to the Lake Cumberland Regional Hospital by private vehicle. Carter was transported by ambulance. Seat belts were in use at the time of the accident.

Carter was pronounced dead at the hospital by Pulaski County Chief Deputy Coroner Jim McWhorter.

The accident is being reconstructed by Officer Eric Moore. The roadway was blocked for about 1 hour and 10 minutes.

SPD units were assisted at the scene by the Somerset Fire/EMS and the Pulaski County Coroner's Office.
