Work Detail Prisoner Captured in Tennessee

An inmate who walked away from a work detail on June 25 has been captured.

Gary Burgess Rollins, 48, of Parkers Lake in McCreary County was arrested shortly after 8:30AM this morning at the Greyhound bus terminal in Chattanooga, Tennessee.

Rollins was last seen June 25 when he fled a work release detail he was working at the Pulaski County Animal Shelter. He was serving an eight-year sentence for drug trafficking and bail jumping.

Somerset police received a tip that Rollins was enroute from London, Kentucky to Chattanooga on a Greyhound bus that departed during the early Tuesday morning hours.

Detectives passed on available information to the Chattanooga Police Department shortly before Rollins' arrival. Officers made the arrest without incident.

Rollins was travelling with 21-year-old Angel Wilson, also of McCreary County. Wilson was arrested by Chattanooga officers and charged with unlawful carrying of a weapon, criminal impersonation, possession of controlled substance, possession of contraband penal institutions.

Both were lodged in the Hamilton County Jail.

Rollins will go before a local judge to determine extradition back to Pulaski County.
