Fugitive Arrested

On July 29, 2008, Somerset police arrested Oscar Lee Long, age 42, of Olive Hill, Kentucky after determining he was wanted by authorities in three states.

Long was arrested at about 3:30PM Tuesday by Detective Shannon Smith after confirming Bath, Carter, and Rowan Counties in Kentucky had active warrants on him for not showing up in court.

A further check of NCIC files showed Long was wanted in Virginia and Florida.

He was wanted in Wise County, Virginia for a felony charge of writing a bad check. Lee County, Florida had a felony warrant for Long's arrest for a 2007 case where he failed to return a rented vehicle in Fort Meyers.

Long was lodged in the Pulaski County Detention Center.

He will appear in front of a Pulaski District Court judge to determine if he will waive extradition to Florida and Virginia.

The investigation is continuing.
